

Worried about a friend or family member?

Ask if you or someone they trust can hold on to their firearms



Safe storage saves lives

Many suicide attempts are impulsive. Temporary safe storage gives a person time to think and cool down.



Create time and distance

Placing time and space between a suicidal person and a lethal method like a firearm or medication will likely save their life.



Try different storage options

If the person is uncomfortable voluntarily handing over their firearms, consider holding onto the ammunition, purchasing a gun safe, or using a gunlock instead. Order free gunlocks and drug deactivation kits at <u>safercommunitiesmt.org</u>.
